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Hip Arthroscopy Post Operative Instructions

You've had arthroscopic hip surgery today. Your hip joint and labrum were evaluated thoroughly. I found in your hip: Arthritis Ligament Damage Labral tearing Synovitis Pincer impingement lesion Cam impingement lesion I was able to: ___Shave bone spurs ___Clean Arthritis Remove Bursitis Debride labrum ___Repair labrum ____Repair/Shave cartilage damage Until I see you, you should: ___Non weight bearing ____Partial weight bearing <50% ____Weight bearing as tolerated ___Stationary bike ___Post op day Start physical therapy (a referral has been given)

You should change your dressing in 2 days. Cover the portals with band aids. We will remove all stitches at your visit. You may shower at 48 hours but do not soak the incisions.

Pain is expected for several weeks. Use your medication for severe pain. You can also take Aleve 500 mg twice daily (if not allergic, or no ulcer history). Call if fever greater than 101.5°, or if infection is noted. Call 549-8249 for office visit **7-10** days after surgery. If you want to return to work before your next visit, call the office.
